Chardonnay 100%

WINEMAKING

Picked in the cool of the evening at optimal ripeness, the wine was fermented in tank with minimal malolactic fermentation to maintain fruit intensity and freshness. The wine was bottled soon after finishing ferment, fined and filtered to preserve the fresh fruit flavours from the vine in the glass.

COLOUR

Delicate pale straw.

AROMA

Aromas of melon and tropical fruits.

PALATE

The citric balance of green apples evens out the tropical fruit mid-palate, softened with a creamy texture and crisp, silken finish.
