Semillon 77.2%, Sauvignon Blanc 22.8%

WINEMAKING

Picked in the cool of the evening at optimal ripeness, the wine was tank fermented to dry in order to maintain fruit intensity and freshness. The wine was bottled soon after finishing ferment, fined and filtered to preserve the fresh fruit flavours from the vine in the glass.

COLOUR

Delicate pale straw.

AROMA

Notes of kaffir lime and lifted gooseberry.

PALATE

A bright, clean style with tropical notes and a citrus balanced structure. An elegant wine with finesse and length.
