### WINEMAKING

Harvested at various °Baume to increase flavour complexity and fermented in tank at cool, then slowly increasing temperatures to promote dense fruit flavour and colour extraction. The finished parcels of wine were then blended prior to bottling to maintain the style with minimal fining or filtration.

### COLOUR

Dark crimson.

### AROMA

Notes of blackberry with white pepper hints.

### PALATE

Dense rich berry fruits with fine tannins and a delicate structure.
