The story of Thomson Estate dates back to 1838 when Walter and Jane Thomson sailed from Britain to South Australia, with records of the day listing Walter as a Farmer and a Vigneron.

WINEMAKING

The parcels of fruit going into this wine were marked early in the vintage as being of exceptional quality. Picked and handled separately, the fruit was crushed, and then fermented in stainless steel, deliberately halting malolactic fermentation in order to preserve the vibrancy of the wine.

COLOUR

Delicate gold with green hints.

AROMA

Pineapple and green apple, with slight grassy notes.

PALATE

The tropical notes are balanced out nicely by a lingering green apple acid line, with the creamy texture an apt counterpoint. Bright and vibrant, this chardonnay epitomizes the quality of the family Riverland vineyards.
