



## THOMSON ESTATE Clare Valley Shiraz 2010

The story of Thomson Estate dates back to 1838 when Walter and Jane Thomson sailed from Britain to South Australia, with records of the day listing Walter as a Farmer and a Vigneron.



Thomson Estate Vineyards are located in the northern reaches of the picturesque region of the Clare Valley. These vineyards were planted over 40 years ago, on limestone gravel soils. The cool nights and warm summer days have produced a wine with power, structure and finesse.

### FRUIT

The Shiraz was sourced from our northern Clare properties, which tend to evoke dark fruits and silken spice.

### WINEMAKING

The parcels were hand selected for the Estate Shiraz label and cold soaked in order to intensify the fruit characters. With a little assistance from some old French oak, the wine was left to happily ferment away and settle into itself.

### AROMA

Dense dark berries on the nose, with a hint of cranberry, and gentle oak notes.

### PALATE

Classically Clare Shiraz – with some minty notes, backed by a rich dark fruit character, and silken tannins. A gentle structure, enhanced by delicate spices and notes of anise and cardamom.
