WINEMAKING

Picked in the cool of the evening at optimal ripeness, the wine was tank fermented to dry to maintain fruit intensity and freshness.

The wine was bottled soon after finishing ferment, fined and filtered to preserve the fresh fruit flavours from the vine to the glass.

COLOUR

Delicate pale straw.

AROMA

Bright notes of kaffir lime, peach blossom and lifted gooseberry.

PALATE

A bright, vibrant style with tropical notes, floral lift and a zesty-citrus balanced structure.
