Region	Clare Valley, South Australia		
Winemaking	Carefully selected parcels of shiraz from the Blights block Byrne vineyard in Northern Clare, were picked in the evening in March, left to macerate over night and crushed early the next morning. The wine was fermented in older French barrels, and left to age in oak before bottling in November 2015. The 2013 vintage was a particularly dry one, and Cabernet Sauvignon performed consistently in the region.		
Colour	Deep currant red colour.		
Nose	Briar and chocolate with plummy richness		
Palate	A refined and structured style, with elegant tannins, this wine has intense cassis characters and subtle oak influence. The wine has a concentrated palate with layers of dark berry fruit and Morello cherry complexed by spice characters.		
Food Pairing:	Herb lamb shanks slow roasted with root vegetables, pork ribs or spicy Asian dishes.
